



The table below identifies how credit is awarded for Advanced Placement content areas.

- · Linfield awards four credits for each Advanced Placement exam when a score of 4 or 5 is earned.
- Students may count up to a total of 31 credits from Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, and other non-course credits towards the 125 required for graduation.
- Credits from any one AP exam may be used to fulfill only one general education area. If an AP subject has two areas listed you can choose where you would like it to apply.
